Reviewer B:

This is an article that raises serious issues in a society where there are likely to be an increasing number of inter-faith marriages. It raises sensitive and painful issues for family members regarding the disposal of family members following death.

The article is based almost totally on secondary sources. It could be improved by direct reference to primary sources eg. interviews and legal documents.

A major issue relates to the coherence of the article. It needs to be language edited because in its present state many statements are unclear and need to be clarified. This would make it more publishable.

There are, what I would call, a number of carelessnesses in the text, eg.

There is a repeated section on lines 65ff, cf, lines 161ff

Line 257 'Straud' rather than 'Stroud'

Line 282 – use of 'doctrine' rather than 'beliefs'?

Repetitive misspelling of 'corpse' throughout the text

Lines 398 ff – check quote.
