Reviewer B:

This is an interesting paper. It is one of the few to consider religion and culture in Banyumas. The author should devote more attention to religion and culture in the region and provide a more detailed description of the ritual and the socio context in which it is located. Who performs it, when, where and why. More basic ethnographic description is needed.

The author devotes too much space to discussing old orientalist views of "syncretism" and related issues. This can be put into a single paragraph. It is also not clear that the discussion of Hamsa Fansuri, Ibn Arabi etc. is relevant to the analysis of the ritual complex under investigation. It would be more relevant to discuss angles, jinn etc.

The paper needs a stronger introduction that tells readers what is under investigation and where the research was conducted.

Lines 70-76 These are Salafi positions and should be described as such.

139 Ethnic groups not tribes,.

174 "raised" I'm not sure what this means.

239 nand throughout. There is too much emphasis on Hindu/Buddhist "culture". There are Hindu and Buddhist cultural traits to be sure and it is not justified to describe the entire culture as Hindu Buddhist.

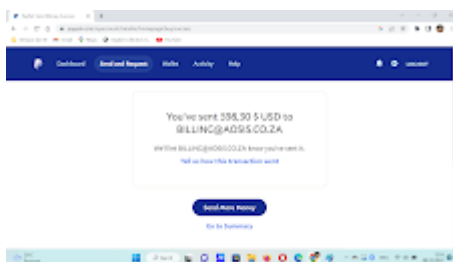

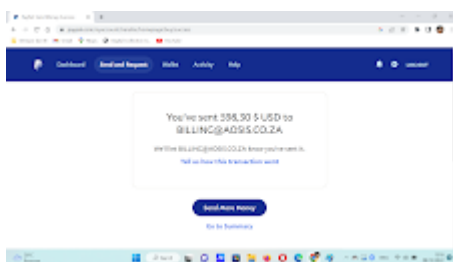
